AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF **ATTORNEY PURPOSES** THE **GENERAL FOR OF ACTIONS** INITIATING ALL APPROPRIATE LEGAL NECESSARY FOR THE RECOVERY OF COMPACT IMPACT REIMBURSEMENTS FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT: AND TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (f) TO §1512.2 OF TITLE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE 5. GUAM CODE TO AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A LOAN FOR THE LANDFILL COSTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
- 3 finds that under the Compacts of Free Association between the Freely Associated

1 States (FAS) of Micronesia and the U.S. Government, costs incurred by local

2 governments for health care, education and other costs incurred by FAS citizens

3 are calculated by local governments and reimbursed by the U.S. Government. I

4 Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that despite numerous administrative attempts

5 to recoup such amounts Guam continues to be owed in excess of Four Hundred

6 Million Dollars (\$400,000,000) in reimbursement costs attributed to the presence

of FAS citizens utilizing public services. Therefore, it is the intent of I

8 Liheslaturan Guahan to pursue any and all legal actions necessary to compel

reimbursements owed to the government of Guam for costs incurred relative to the

10 Compacts of Free Association.

Section 2. Appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General of Guam. The sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the FY 2009 Guam Highway Fund revenues to the Office of the Attorney General of Guam for the specific use of initiating any and all necessary legal actions necessary for the recovery of Compact Impact reimbursements due to the government of Guam from the U.S. Government. This appropriation *may* include the hiring of personnel, procurement of professional services and any other reasonable costs necessary to successfully pursue this mandate. For this particular purpose, the Office of the Attorney General of Guam is *exempted* from the restriction on the hiring of limited term appointments and unclassified employees. The funds appropriated herein shall be available for expenditure by the Office of the Attorney General of Guam until fully expended.

Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Office of the Attorney General of Guam *shall* submit *monthly* status reports to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* reporting all expenditures associated with this Act, as well as, detailing the progress made in achieving this Mandate.

- Section 4. A new Subsection (f) is hereby *added* to §1512.2 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:
- "(f) Notwithstanding any substantive *or* procedural provision of Chapter 6 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the government of Guam hereby waives immunity from any suit *or* action in contract on the Loan, but *does not* waive sovereign immunity as to the personal liability of elected *or* appointed officials and employees of the government of Guam."
