

AN ACT TO ADJUST THE "VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION" FEE BY *AMENDING* §3602 OF ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds that many of the fees now charged by the government of Guam for services were established more than two (2) decades ago. However, the cost of providing the services has increased tremendously due to normal increases in the cost-of-living and improvements in how these services are provided. One such service is the "vehicle safety inspection", the fee for which was last adjusted in July 1986 from Five Dollars (\$5) to Seven Dollars (\$7). Therefore, I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends

to enable the government to recover the cost of providing said vehicle safety inspections.

Section 2. §3602 of Chapter 3, Article 6, Title 16 Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

- "§3602. Regulations: Fee. (a) The Director of Revenue and Taxation is hereby authorized to make necessary rules and regulations, subject to the approval of *I Maga'Lahi*, for the administration and enforcement of inspections required under §3601, including designation of the period *or* periods of time within which said inspections *shall* be made and for the issuance and use of decalcomania *or* other identification to be attached to vehicles with reference to inspection status.
- (b) The fee to be charged for each such inspection *shall* be Fifteen Dollars (\$15), inclusive of the administrative fee of Three Dollars (\$3). The fee for re-inspection done pursuant to \$3601(c) *shall* be Two Dollars (\$2). Commercial and Armed Forces of the United States vehicle safety inspection stations *shall* retain all fees collected as payment for inspection services rendered, however, such stations *shall* be required to purchase official inspection administrative forms from the Department of Revenue and Taxation. All fees received by the Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall* be deposited in the General Fund of the Treasury of Guam."
- Section 3. Public Notification Prior to Effective Date. The Director of Revenue and Taxation *shall* provide proper notice of the fees adjusted hereby to the inspection stations operating pursuant to Title 11 GCA §3603 and to the public *no later than* forty-five (45) days from the enactment hereof.
- 25 Section 4. Effective Date. The adjusted fees shall be effective no later 26 than sixty (60) days after the enactment hereof.
