**AN ACT TO ADJUST THE “VEHICLE SAFETY
INSPECTION” FEE BY *AMENDING* §3602 OF ARTICLE 6,
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslatura* finds that
3 many of the fees now charged by the government of Guam for services were
4 established more than two (2) decades ago. However, the cost of providing the
5 services has increased tremendously due to normal increases in the cost-of-living
6 and improvements in how these services are provided. One such service is the
7 “vehicle safety inspection”, the fee for which was last adjusted in July 1986 from
8 Five Dollars (\$5) to Seven Dollars (\$7). Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends

1 to enable the government to recover the cost of providing said vehicle safety
2 inspections.

3 **Section 2.** §3602 of Chapter 3, Article 6, Title 16 Guam Code Annotated is
4 hereby *amended* to read:

5 “§3602. **Regulations: Fee.** (a) The Director of Revenue and
6 Taxation is hereby authorized to make necessary rules and regulations,
7 subject to the approval of *I Maga’Lahi*, for the administration and
8 enforcement of inspections required under §3601, including designation of
9 the period *or* periods of time within which said inspections *shall* be made
10 and for the issuance and use of decalomania *or* other identification to be
11 attached to vehicles with reference to inspection status.

12 (b) The fee to be charged for each such inspection *shall* be Fifteen
13 Dollars (\$15), inclusive of the administrative fee of Three Dollars (\$3). The
14 fee for re-inspection done pursuant to §3601(c) *shall* be Two Dollars (\$2).
15 Commercial and Armed Forces of the United States vehicle safety
16 inspection stations *shall* retain all fees collected as payment for inspection
17 services rendered, however, such stations *shall* be required to purchase
18 official inspection administrative forms from the Department of Revenue
19 and Taxation. All fees received by the Department of Revenue and Taxation
20 *shall* be deposited in the General Fund of the Treasury of Guam.”

21 **Section 3. Public Notification Prior to Effective Date.** The Director of
22 Revenue and Taxation *shall* provide proper notice of the fees adjusted hereby to
23 the inspection stations operating pursuant to Title 11 GCA §3603 and to the public
24 *no later than* forty-five (45) days from the enactment hereof.

25 **Section 4. Effective Date.** The adjusted fees *shall* be effective *no later*
26 *than* sixty (60) days after the enactment hereof.
