AN ACT TO AMEND §§2109 AND 2110 OF CHAPTER 2, AND TO AMEND §§6230 AND 6231 OF CHAPTER 6, ALL OF TITLE 4 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING “LAME DUCK” INCUMBENTS FROM HIRING NEW, UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES FOLLOWING THE LOSS OF AN ELECTION AND TO PROHIBIT SALARY INCREASES FOR UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES FOLLOWING THE LOSS OF AN ELECTION OR THE DECISION *NOT* TO SEEK RE-ELECTION BY AN INCUMBENT ELECTED OFFICIAL.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §2109 of Chapter 2, 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

1 **"§2109. Prohibition Against Hiring New, Unclassified**
2 **Employees Following the Defeat of an Incumbent in an Election.** No new
3 unclassified employees may be hired in the Executive Branch of government
4 following the defeat of a sitting *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* in a primary election *or*
5 general election until after such date that such *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* leaves office.
6 No new, unclassified employees may be hired in any Legislative Office of a sitting
7 Senator following the defeat of such Senator in a primary *or* general election. No
8 new contract workers *or* unclassified employees may be hired in the Department
9 of Law following the defeat of a sitting Attorney General in a primary *or* general
10 election until said Attorney General leaves office. No new unclassified employees
11 may be hired in the Office of the Public Auditor following the defeat of said
12 Public Auditor in a primary *or* general election until said Public Auditor leaves
13 office. Following the defeat of a sitting Attorney General in a primary *or* general
14 election, no contract workers *or* unclassified employees employed in the Office of
15 the Attorney General may receive a pay increase until said Attorney General
16 leaves office. Following the defeat of a sitting Public Auditor in a primary *or*
17 general election, no contract workers *or* unclassified employees employed in the
18 Office of the Public Auditor may receive a pay increase until said Public Auditor
19 leaves office."

20 **Section 2.** §2110 of Chapter 2, 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

21 **"§2110. Prohibition Against Hiring Unclassified Employees**
22 **Employed by Incumbents Not Seeking Re-election.** (a) No new unclassified
23 employees may be hired in the Executive Branch of government after October 1st
24 of the last year of office of a sitting *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* who is not seeking re-
25 election until after such date that such *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* leaves office. No

1 new, unclassified employees may be hired in any Legislative Office of a sitting
2 Senator, opting not to seek re-election, after October 1st of the last year in office
3 of such Senator. No contract workers *or* unclassified employees employed in the
4 Department of Law *or* the Office of the Public Auditor may be hired following the
5 defeat of Attorney General *or* Public Auditor, respectively, in a primary *or* general
6 election until that Attorney General *or* Public Auditor leaves office.”

7 **Section 3.** §6230 of Chapter 6, 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

8 **“§6230. Prohibition Against Salary Increases for Unclassified**
9 **Employees Following the Defeat of an Incumbent in an Election.** No
10 unclassified employees employed in the Executive Branch of government may
11 receive a pay increase following the defeat of a sitting *Maga’lahen Guåhan* in a
12 primary election *or* general election until after such date that such *Maga’lahen*
13 *Guåhan* leaves office. No unclassified employees employed in any Legislative
14 Office of a sitting Senator may receive a pay increase following the defeat of such
15 Senator in a primary *or* general election. No unclassified employees employed in
16 any Mayoral Office of a sitting Mayor may receive a pay increase following the
17 defeat of such Mayor in a primary *or* general election. No contract workers *or*
18 unclassified employees employed in the Department of Law *or* the Office of the
19 Public Auditor may receive a pay increase following the defeat of Attorney
20 General *or* Public Auditor, respectively, in a primary *or* general election until that
21 Attorney General *or* Public Auditor leaves office.”

22 **Section 4.** §6231 of Chapter 6, 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

23 **“§6231. Prohibition Against Salary Increases for Unclassified**
24 **Employees Employed by Incumbents *Not* Seeking Re-election.** No unclassified
25 employees employed in the Executive Branch of government may receive a pay

1 increase after October 1st of the last year of office of a sitting *Maga'lahaen Guåhan*
2 who is *not* seeking re-election until after such date that such *Maga'lahaen Guåhan*
3 leaves office. No unclassified employees employed in any Legislative Office of a
4 sitting Senator, opting not to seek re-election, may receive a pay increase after
5 October 1st of the last year in office of such Senator. No unclassified employees
6 employed in any Mayoral Office of a sitting Mayor, opting not to seek re-election,
7 may receive a pay increase after October 1st of the last year in office of such
8 Mayor. *If* an incumbent Attorney General *or* Public Auditor decides not to seek
9 re-election, no contract workers *or* unclassified employees employed in the
10 Department of Law *or* the Office of the Public Auditor, respectively, may receive
11 a pay increase after October 1st of the respective official's last year in office. "
