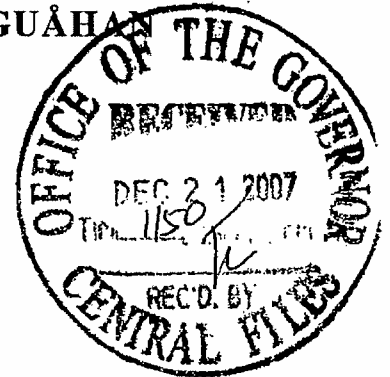





**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §§50.54 AND 50.58 OF CHAPTER 50 OF
TITLE 8 GCA, RELATIVE TO ALLOWING FOR THE
INDICTMENTS OF UNNAMED PERSONS WHOSE
IDENTITIES ARE ESTABLISHED BY DNA EVIDENCE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §50.54 of Chapter 50 of Title 8 GCA is hereby *amended* to
3 read:

4 **“§50.54. Form of Indictment: Standards for Indicting.** (a) An
5 indictment is an accusation in writing, presented by the grand jury to a
6 competent court, charging a person with a felony *or* a felony and a related
7 misdemeanor.

1 (b) The grand jury *shall* find an indictment when from the evidence
2 presented there is reasonable cause to believe that an indictable offense has
3 been committed and that the defendant committed it.

4 (c) *Special Fictitious Name Indictment* means an indictment of a
5 person whose name is unknown but whose identity is established to the
6 satisfaction of a grand jury by means of forensic Deoxyribonucleic Acid
7 (DNA) testing of evidence. The caption of a special fictitious name
8 indictment *shall* include a fictitious name, such as “John Doe” *or* “Jane
9 Doe”, in place of the name of the defendant whose true name is unknown.”

10 **Section 2.** §50.58 of Chapter 50 of Title 8 GCA is hereby *amended* to read:

11 “**§50.58. Return of Indictment.** An indictment may be found only
12 upon the concurrence of twelve (12) *or* more jurors. The indictment *shall*
13 be returned by the grand jury to a judge in open court. *If* the defendant has
14 been arrested and twelve (12) jurors do not concur in finding an indictment,
15 the foreman *shall* so report to the court in writing forthwith.

16 When the name of the indicted person is unknown but his *or* her
17 identity is established to the satisfaction of the grand jury by means of
18 forensic Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) testing of evidence, then such
19 indictment *shall* be filed by the grand jury with the Court as a Special
20 Fictitious Name Indictment. The authority to file a special fictitious name
21 indictment pursuant to this Section *shall* be in addition to any other
22 authority in law for the filing of an indictment when the name of an indicted
23 person is unknown.”
