**AN ACT TO AMEND §55102(d) OF CHAPTER 55,
DIVISION 3, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR
SUBMISSION OF THE REVIEW AND
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND
LAW ENFORCEMENT COMPENSATION AND
BENEFITS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** Public Law No. 28-154
3 established a process for a comprehensive review of the compensation, benefits,
4 position requirement, and duties of public safety and law enforcement officers of the
5 government of Guam. The end goal of the process is to make recommendations to *I*

1 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and to other government officials that will address internal
2 inequity and external competitiveness. Based on meetings and discussions already
3 held by the Department of Administration, it is revealed that the process is complex
4 and complicated, involving twelve (12) different disciplines, with each discipline
5 comprising of five (5) to eight (8) levels of grade *or* rank. The Department of
6 Administration determined that due to these conditions, the deadline by which to
7 submit its final recommendations cannot be met. The Department of Administration
8 accordingly requests, through written communication dated May 9, 2007, for an
9 extension of time in order that it perform a comprehensive, thorough, and proper
10 review and recommendation that Public Law 28-154 requires. It is, therefore, the
11 intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend §55102(d) of Chapter 55, Division 3, Title
12 10 Guam Code Annotated, relative to extending the deadline for the submission of the
13 review and recommendations for public safety and law enforcement compensation and
14 benefits.

15 **Section 2.** §55102(d) of Chapter 55, Division 3, Title 10 Guam Code
16 Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

17 “(d) The Director of Administration *shall* commence said review
18 upon enactment hereof and *no later than* April 30, 2008, *shall* issue a
19 report that includes recommendations of the Human Relations Officer
20 Coordinating Council (HROCC), as established by Title 4 GCA,
21 §4101.1(j), and stating his findings and recommendations. The Director
22 *shall* provide the report to *I Maga’lahen Guåhan, I Liheslaturan Guåhan,*
23 the Judicial Council, the Administrator of the Courts, the Chief of Police,
24 the Guam Fire Chief, the Director of Corrections, the Director of Youth
25 Affairs, the Attorney General, the Chief of Customs and Quarantine, the
26 Chief of Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority Police, the
27 Chief of Police of the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority,

1 Guam, the Director of Parks and Recreation and the Director of
2 Agriculture, and *shall* post and notice the report in the manner prescribed
3 in Title 4 GCA, Chapter 6, §6303.1(a).”
