AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §849 TO ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 1 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO NAME THE TUMON/TAMUNING POLICE STATION THE "SGT. FRANKIE E. SMITH POLICE STATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings. I Liheslaturan Guåhan would like to
- 3 honor the service of Sgt. Frankie E. Smith, a police officer assigned to the
- 4 Tumon/Tamuning Police Station who died in the line of duty on December 30,
- 5 2007, while answering a call to a disturbance in Tumon. This officer embodied the
- 6 ideal of the good policeman: he was full of character and compassion, and was

1 well loved by his coworkers. Sgt. Smith is a reminder that a policeman is always

2 in danger, even in the most ordinary of circumstances, and his loss to the island a

3 few days after Christmas is more than a loss to his family and friends, but a loss to

4 the entire Guam community of an educated, capable and compassionate guardian

of our community. It is fitting that the Tumon/Tamuning Police Station where he

6 worked should be named after him.

Section 2. A new §849 is *added* to Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 1 Guam 8 Code Annotated to read:

"§849. Sgt. Frankie E. Smith Police Station. The Tumon/Tamuning Police Station located on #1041 Pale San Vitores Road, Tumon, Guam is named the "Sgt. Frankie E. Smith Police Station" in honor of Sgt. Frankie E. Smith who gave his life in the performance of his duty in Tumon on December 30, 2007."
