



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §61.30 OF CHAPTER 61 OF TITLE
9 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
LOITERING IN *OR* AROUND SCHOOL BUS STOPS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §61.30 of Title 9 GCA Chapter 61 is hereby *amended* to read:

“§61.30. Loitering *or* Prowling; Defined & Punished; Defenses.

(a) A person commits a violation *if* he loiters *or* prowls in a place, at a time, *or* in a manner not usual for law-abiding individuals under circumstances that warrant alarm for the safety of persons *or* property in the vicinity. Among the circumstances which may be considered in determining whether such alarm is warranted is the fact that the person takes

1 flight upon appearance of a peace officer, refuses to identify himself, *or*
2 manifestly endeavors to conceal himself *or* any object.

3 A person commits a violation *if* he loiters *or* prowls in *or* in close
4 proximity to a school bus stop, at a time, *or* in a manner not usual for law-
5 abiding individuals under circumstances that warrant alarm for the safety of
6 persons *or* property in the vicinity.

7 (b) Unless flight by the person *or* other circumstances makes it
8 impracticable, a peace officer *shall* prior to any arrest for an offense under
9 this Section afford the person an opportunity to dispel any alarm which
10 would otherwise be warranted, by requesting him to identify himself and
11 explain his presence and conduct.

12 (c) No person *shall* be convicted of an offense under this Section *if*
13 the peace officer did not comply with Subsection (b) *or if* it appears at trial
14 that the explanation given by the person was true and, *if* believed by the
15 peace officer at the time would have dispelled the alarm.”
