AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION 4(a) OF CHAPTER 19 OF TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING INSURANCE COMPANIES TO NOTIFY, BY ELECTRONIC MAIL, THE DEPARTMENT OF **MOTOR** REVENUE AND **TAXATION OF VEHICLE** INSURANCE ISSUANCE, CANCELLATIONS OR NON-RENEWALS WITHIN TEN (10) WORKING DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF ISSUANCE, CANCELLATION OR NON-RENEWAL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

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**Section 1.** Subsection 4(a) of §19103, Chapter 19 of Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"(4)(a) All insurers authorized to sell motor vehicle insurance on Guam shall electronically submit to the Department of Revenue and Taxation, using the department's established mechanism for electronic submission over the internet or secure network, notice of motor vehicle insurance issuance, cancellations or nonrenewals within ten (10) working days after the effective date of issuance, cancellation or non-renewal. All insurers authorized to sell motor vehicle insurance on Guam shall comply with this electronic submission requirement within one hundred eighty (180) days of the enactment of this Act. All insurance companies authorized to sell motor vehicle insurance on Guam shall provide notification to the Department of Revenue and Taxation by electronic mail, written form or the Department of Revenue and Taxation's mechanism for electronic transmission over the internet or secure network prior to the effective date to meet notification requirements of this Section. In the event power or system failure does not permit electronic notice, insurers shall submit written notice to the Department of Revenue and Taxation within ten (10) working days after the effective date of issuance, cancellation or non-renewal.

Upon receipt of the notice of cancellation concerning a motor vehicle insurance policy on a vehicle registered in Guam, the Director *shall* notify the person in whose name the vehicle is registered and the lien holder that the Director will revoke *or* cancel registration of the vehicle pursuant to law."
