
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 85(b) OF CHAPTER VI OF
PUBLIC LAW 29-19, RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE
DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE
ABUSE TO EXPEND GOVERNMENT FUNDS FOR
CLASSIFIED AND UNCLASSIFIED POSITIONS WITHIN
THE CHILD MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVE PROGRAM, *I*
FAMAGU'ON-TA SYSTEM OF CARE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Section 85(b) of Chapter VI of Public Law 29-19 is hereby
3 *amended* to read:

4 “(b) The sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000)
5 from the appropriations contained in Section 1(a) of Part III of Chapter III of

1 this Act *shall* be used for the operations and support of the Child Mental
2 Health Initiative Program, *I Famagu'on-ta* System of Care, to support
3 children and adolescents under twenty-two (22) years of age with serious
4 emotional disturbances and their families. Notwithstanding Chapter VI,
5 Section 19 of this Act and any other provision of law, the monies herein
6 described *shall* be available for the payment of salaries and benefits of all
7 existing personnel, including classified and unclassified positions of the
8 program.”

9 **Section 2. Severability.** *If* any of the provisions of this Act or the
10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity
11 shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given
12 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of
13 this Act are severable.
