

AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §54105 TO TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO MANDATING THE PRIORITY OF INCORPORATING BICYCLE LANES AND PEDESTRIAN WAYS IN THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF FUTURE GUAM TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new §54105 is hereby *added* to Title 5 of the Guam Code
3 Annotated, Article 1, Chapter 54, to read:

4 “§54105. (a) Inclusion of bicycle lanes and pedestrian ways *shall*
5 be part and parcel of the planning, development, construction, reconstruction
6 *or* other change of transportation facilities, plans, programs of primary and
7 secondary roads on Guam.

1 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a), bicycle lanes
2 and pedestrian ways are *not* required to be established when their
3 establishment would be contrary to public safety.

4 The Department of Public Works *shall* establish construction
5 standards and a uniform system of signage for bicycle lanes and pedestrian
6 ways.”

7 **Section 2. Severability.** *If* any of the provisions of this Act or the
8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity
9 shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given
10 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of
11 this Act are severable.
