An Act making an appropriation of Two Mundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) for the establishment of the Working Capital Fund, to finance the operations of the Division of Procurement and Supply, Department of Finance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPIE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any monies in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, as a portion of the appropriation for the government of Guam for the fiscal year 1954, the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000), to establish the Norking Capital Fund of the Department of Finance.

Section 2. The purpose of the Working Capital Fund is to finance the Division of Procurement and Supply, including but not limited to procurement and warehousing of all operating supplies, equipment, materials, printing and binding of the government of Guam, and operation costs of the Division of Procurement and Supply, including but not limited to personal services, travel, communication, printing, contractural services, supplies, materials and equipment. The fund shall be utilized in such manner as to obtain for the government of Guam maximum benefits and advantages available through efficient, gentralized purchasing and warehousing of materials, supplies and equipment for the use of all departments and agencies of the government.

Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to utilize the Working Capital Fund, and to delagate to a qualified employee or employees of the government of Guam authority to authorize expenditures from said fund in accordance with standard government procedure and to carry out the purposes of this act.

Section 6. The Working Capital Fund shall be in continuing force and effect so long as required, and shall not expire on a fiscal year basis.

Section 5. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to es-

tablish and maintain prices and rates of surcharges on all supplies, materials, equipment and services issued and rendered to all departments and agencies of the government of Cuna by the Division of Procurement and Supply, to the end that insofar as possible the Morking Capital Fund shall be self-maintaining.

Section 6. The Director of Finance shall make periodic reports in the form and manner and at such times as the Governor may direct, relating to the operations of the Norking Capital Fund.

Section 7. In addition to the appropriation hereby made, the Governor is authorized to transfer the additional sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Bellars (\$250,000) from allocations made for supplies and equipment in the operating budget for the fiscal year 1954 to the fund hereby created to be used for the purposes and in the manner herein set forth.
