


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



Substitute Bill by Committee on
Finance and Taxation.

An Act authorizing the inception and continuation of certain necessary capital improvements within the territory of Guam and to make appropriations for such purposes and projects; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. It is the purpose of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act to authorize the continuance of the ten-year construction program for necessary, adequate and appropriate public works, buildings, structures and facilities required for the operation of the Government and in the interest of the public welfare and safety of the people, and in order to continue the rehabilitation of the territory of Guam, and to make necessary appropriations therefor.

Section 2. The Governor is hereby authorized to construct, erect, install, extend, establish, maintain or develop, by contract or otherwise, for the government of Guam, necessary, adequate and appropriate public works, buildings, structures, land, installations, facilities, and equipment as herein below specified and for which appropriations are herein made.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any General Fund surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, the following sums of money for the purposes and projects as herein set forth:

(1) To continue the construction of the permanent Umatac School building including painting, electrical wiring and fixtures and to provide equipment and other collateral facilities therefor, the sum of \$14,600.

(2) To continue the construction of the permanent Inarajan Elementary school building, the sum of \$16,500.

1 (3) To begin construction of a connecting road between Routes
2 2 and 4 between Agat and Umatac, the sum of \$75,000.

3 (4) To construct a bridge over Talofofe River on Route 4, the
4 sum of \$45,000.

5 (5) To begin construction and development of the Paseo de Susana
6 Park, the sum of \$17,000.

7 (6) To improve or develop the Asotea structure and grounds and
8 the Old Spanish Bridge Area in Agana, the sum of \$3,000.

9 (7) To overhaul, extend and install additions to the drainage
10 area in Piti, the sum of \$5,000.

11 (8) To overhaul and extend the drainage system for Agana by
12 clearing and deepening the Agana River Channel through the reef to improve
13 the drainage thereof, the sum of \$20,000.

14 (9) For the Public Utility Agency, to install fire hydrants as
15 part of the water system in Santa Rita, the sum of \$1,150.

16 (10) For the Public Utility Agency, to construct a water system
17 at Inarajan, including a reservoir and appropriate facilities, the sum
18 of \$30,000.

19 (11) For the Public Utility Agency, to construct water mains,
20 approximately 34,700 linear feet of lines, along Routes 10 and 15, the
21 sum of \$217,000.

22 (12) For the Public Utility Agency, to extend, further construct,
23 install, or improve water system lines and facilities at Piti, the sum
24 of \$5,000.

25 (13) For the Public Utility Agency, to extend, further construct,
26 install, or improve water system lines and facilities at Agat, the sum
27 of \$15,000.

28 (14) For the Public Utility Agency, to extend, further construct,
29 install, or improve water system lines and facilities at Talofofe, the
30 sum of \$5,000.

31 (15) For the Public Utility Agency, to extend, further construct,
32 install, or improve water system lines and facilities at Yona, the sum

1 of \$10,000.

2 (16) For the Public Utility Agency, to install, construct,
3 extend, or improve electric power distribution lines and facilities at
4 Afasi, Sinajana, the sum of \$5,000. *Disapproved Aug 73 1954*

5 (17) For the Public Utility Agency to install, construct, extend
6 or improve electric power lines and facilities at Maina, Asan, the sum
7 of \$5,000. *Disapproved Aug. 73 1954.*

8 (18) For the Public Utility Agency, to install, construct,
9 extend or improve water system lines and facilities at Tumon, Dedede,
10 the sum of \$25,000.

11 (19) For the Public Utility Agency, to install, construct,
12 extend or improve water system lines and facilities at the Dedede area,
13 the sum of \$25,000.

14 (20) To continue construction by asphalt paving Asan streets,
15 the sum of \$12,000.

16 (21) To construct, improve or extend Santa Rita streets or roads,
17 the sum of \$5,000.

18 (22) To construct a road between Inarajan and Atate, the sum of
19 \$15,000.

20 (23) To continue construction by asphalt paving Barrigada
21 streets, the sum of \$30,000.

22 (24) To construct, improve or extend Hongmong-Toto roads and
23 streets, the sum of \$10,000.

24 (25) To develop, construct, or improve a recreation center
25 including appropriate facilities thereto, at Sinajana, the sum of \$10,000.

26 (26) To continue construction by asphalt paving Sinajana streets,
27 the sum of \$30,000.

28 (27) To improve or extend roads at Yigo, the sum of \$7,000.

29 (28) To construct, improve or extend Fagua road at Moriso, the
30 sum of \$2,000.

31 (29) To add, relocate or remodel classrooms at Yigo School and
32 to purchase necessary facilities and collateral equipment therefor, the

1 sum of \$2,418.

2 (30) To construct a standard reinforced concrete, twelve-
3 classroom school to replace the present Price School at Mangilao, and
4 for necessary facilities and equipment required in connection therewith,
5 the sum of \$168,000.

6 (31) To add, relocate, or remodel classrooms at present Price
7 School and to purchase necessary facilities and collateral equipment
8 therefor, the sum of \$4,833.

9 (32) To add, relocate, or remodel classrooms at Barrigada School
10 and to purchase necessary facilities and collateral equipment therefor,
11 the sum of \$5,749.

12 (33) To remodel the laboratory and biology building of the
13 George Washington High School and to provide necessary facilities and
14 collateral equipment therefor, the sum of \$27,000.

15 (34) To provide additional desks for George Washington High
16 School, the sum of \$8,000.

17 (35) To rehabilitate toilet facilities in the Boys' Physical
18 Education Building and in Building "L" of the George Washington High
19 School, the sum of \$4,000.

20 (36) To remodel the Department of Education Administration
21 Building for office space, classrooms, and necessary collateral facili-
22 ties and equipment therefor, the sum of \$20,000.

23 (37) To remodel and rehabilitate the George Washington High
24 School Auditorium including re-roofing and installation of shower rooms
25 and toilet facilities, the sum of \$18,000.

26 (38) To improve roads, and further construct pavements and
27 concrete steps within the George Washington High School area, the sum
28 of \$8,000.

29 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any General Fund
30 surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, the follow-
31 ing sums of money for the purposes and projects as herein set forth:

32 (1) To authorize expenditures of \$45,151.66 incurred against

1 the appropriation made by Section 2(6), Public Law 29, First Guam
2 Legislature, First Regular Session, for repairs of roads damaged as a
3 result of Typhoon Alice.

4 (2) To rehabilitate and paint Department of Public Works
5 Buildings, the sum of \$11,640.

6 (3) To rehabilitate former Bank of America Building, the sum
7 of \$5,000.

8 (4) To rehabilitate Department of Finance Building including
9 the addition of a porch and additional office space, the sum of \$8,000.

10 (5) To repair and paint the Administration Building and other
11 office buildings, the sum of \$8,300.

12 (6) To rehabilitate certain former 103rd NCB housing units, the
13 sum of \$2,400.

14 (7) To purchase and install locker equipment for George
15 Washington High School, the sum of \$20,000.

16 Section 5. The sum of \$24,000 is hereby appropriated from the
17 General Fund surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated,
18 for the construction of eight (8) housing units for staff quarters of
19 the government of Guam.

20 Section 6. The sum of \$8,000 is hereby appropriated from the
21 General Fund surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated,
22 for the purchase of furniture and furnishings for the housing units
23 authorized by Section 5 above.

24 Section 7. Every appropriation made herein shall be available
25 for expenses incident to the project for which the appropriation is made
26 including expenses of administration, planning, supervision and other
27 similar expenses. Each appropriation made herein shall continue in full
28 force and effect and shall be available until expended for the purpose
29 and project for which the appropriation is made.

30 Section 8. The Governor is authorized to acquire lands, rights,
31 pertaining thereto, and easements therein and in connection therewith,
32 or other interests therein, including the temporary use thereof, by

donation, purchase, exchange of government owned lands or otherwise
for all purposes for which appropriations have been made in this Act.

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
