

Substitute Bill by Committee on
Finance and Taxation.

An Act making supplemental appropriations
for the operation of the government of
Guam and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. That the following sums are appropriated, out of
any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, namely:

A. To supplement the appropriations for the operation
of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending
June 30, 1955 as follows:

For the Office of the Governor	\$ 6,500.00
For the Department of Finance	25,955.00
For the Department of Public Works	6,240.00
For the Department of Public Safety	17,000.00
For the Department of Education	5,000.00
For the Public Utility Agency of Guam	18,500.00

B. For contribution by the government of Guam
to the Welfare Fund as authorized by and in
accordance with Chapter 3, Title VII of the
Government Code of Guam. \$30,000.00

C. To supplement the appropriations of the
Judicial Branch for the fiscal year ending
June 30, 1955. \$ 3,582.00

D. To supplement the contingent appropriation
of the Guam Legislature for the fiscal year
ending December 31, 1954. \$31,465.00

Section 2. It is the intent of this Act that the appropriations
made by Section 1A above are supplemental to their respective items of

appropriations made by Section 1 of Public Law Number 2, Second Guam
Legislature, Second Special Session, and that transfers thereto or
therefrom may be made in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of
said Public Law Number 2 as amended from time to time.

Section 3. Section 4, Public Law Number 2, Second Guam Legis-
lature, First Special Session, and Section 4, Public Law Number 2,
Second Guam Legislature, Second Special Session, are herewith repealed.
