



An Act to make an appropriation for the
contingent expenses of the Judicial
Branch of the government of Guam for
the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955,
and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are appropriated out of any moneys
in the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, for the contingent
expenses of the Judicial Branch, government of Guam for the fiscal year
ending ^{June} 30, 1955:

Personal services	\$ 90,085.00
Travel	1,500.00
Communication services	3,000.00
Rent and utility	1,000.00
Printing and binding	1,500.00
Other contractual services	3,500.00
Supplies and materials	3,300.00
Equipment	2,500.00
Retirement Fund	8,766.82
Support and maintenance of minors in foster homes	5,000.00
Support and maintenance of minors in detention home	7,500.00
Personal services (Juvenile Care)	7,500.00
Retirement Fund (Juvenile Care)	711.00
Equipment (Juvenile Care)	2,500.00

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take effect
upon its approval by the Governor.
