

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that since its creation, the appointed Commissioners of the Guam Housing and
4 Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) *do not* receive a stipend for their attendance
5 at Authority meetings. Other similar autonomous agencies within the government
6 of Guam governed by a board *or* commission are authorized by law to compensate
7 its members with a minimal stipend. *I Liheslatura* further finds that Guam

1 Housing and Urban Renewal Authority officials have represented that federal
2 funding is available for the compensation of GHURA Commissioners. Therefore,
3 it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to extend equity to the Commissioners of
4 the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, and to authorize compensation
5 for Commissioners similar to their counterparts in other autonomous agencies.

6 **Section 2.** §5103(f) of Chapter 5, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, is
7 *amended* to read as follows:

8 “(f) A Commissioner *shall* receive *no* compensation for his services,
9 but *shall* be entitled to payment of official travel costs and re-imbusement
10 of expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the discharge of his duties
11 and functions. Commissioners *shall* be compensated in the amount of Fifty
12 Dollars (\$50.00) for attending a board or commission meeting, such
13 compensation *not to exceed* One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month.”



COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation convened a public hearing on Friday, September 18, 2009 at 9:00 A.M. in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 198-30 (COR) – An act to amend 12 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 5 §5103 (f) relative to compensation for Commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority," sponsored by Tina Rose Muña Barnes.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via hand-delivery and e-mailed to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Thursday, September 10, 2009 (5-Day Notice), and again on Tuesday, September 15, 2009 (48-Hour Notice), pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes gave a brief introduction of Bill No. 198-30 (COR) – "An act to amend 12 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 5 §5103 (f) relative to compensation for Commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority.

Chairperson Tina Rose Muna Barnes called those who are present to testify. I have Mrs. Annie L. Paulino here to testify on that (Bill No. 198-30 (COR)), and if anybody from the Board of Directors from Guam Housing and Urban Authority wishes to present testimony, they are welcome to come up and join me. And, if I am not mistaken, there is Mrs.Suda and Mr. Acfalle. Before I have both of you started, I will note for the record that the budget bill that just passed recently which Public Law 30-55:

“Chapter 12, page 149, Section 18. Board of Commission Meeting Stipends. Any compensation or stipend owed to a Board or Commission member for attending a regular *or* special meeting in FY 2010 *shall* be paid from the budget of the department *or* agency responsible for the administrative support and operations of such Boards or Commissions. However, Board and Commission members may elect to *not* receive said compensation.”

I stated that for the record. I have spoken to our legal counsel who has stated that this may intern address the bill that presented before us, but incase, it doesn't on further technical research and legal research, we will go ahead hear public testimony to that and then go head and deliberate that into committee to see whether this bill should proceed forward or not. So that being said, here to testify is Mrs. Annie L. Paulino, Board of Director, GHURA and Mr. Acfalle.

Annie L. Paulino: Thank you Senator Tina Muna Barnes.

Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes: You're welcome.

Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes: Mr. Acfalle.

John Acfalle: My name is John Q. Acfalle and I am a Board member of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority and I also support Bill 198. I have no objection to the bill and I also support that for the other commissioner members, if they're getting paid, or I am not so sure, and I support the bill for the other commission members to be compensated during their meetings. Thank you.

Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes: You're Welcome.

Senator Tina Rose Muna Banres: Speaker Ben, anybody else wishing?

Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes: Senator Rector.

Senator Matt Rector: You know when we talked about the compensating members of Boards and Commissions, I didn't realize that you guys weren't compensated and you certainly should be. Even fifty dollars meaning that there is no way shape of forming pay that you won't cost of getting there and back and the research you do and the time of trouble of your lives, which I thank you both for. But somehow I don't see that there is equity in this when CCU gets thousand dollars a month and you guys are asking for fifty? I think that GHURA has just as important but an important role of our society and the people that use your services and the facilities that you built are crucial to our island and our people. Personally, I think you deserve a thousand dollars a month just like they do of any members of the board that served their time. Thank you.

Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes: Thank you senator Rector. If no one else wishing to speak on bill 198 and then you have ten days for anybody in the listening audience would like to turn in a written testimony you have ten days from today's date. III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation finds that Bill No. 198-30 (COR) intends to compensate the commissioner members of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority.

Accordingly, the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation hereby reports out Bill No. 198-30 (COR), as introduced by the Committee, with the recommendations to *I Mina'Trenta na Liheslaturan Guahan* **TO PASS**, Bill No. 198-30 (COR) AN ACT TO AMEND 12 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED CHAPTER 5 §5103 (f) RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION FOR COMMISSIONERS OF THE GUAM HOUSING AND URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*

Finds that since its creation, the appointed commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority do not receive stipend for their attendance at office commission meetings. Other similar autonomous agencies within the government of Guam govern by a Board or Commission are authorized by law to compensate their members to receive a minimal stipend. *I Liheslatura* further finds, that Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority officials have conveyed that federal funding are available for the compensation of GHURA commissioners. Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to extend equity to commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal and authorizing compensation for commissioners similar to their counterparts in other autonomous

agencies.

Section 2. 12 GCA Chapter 5 §5103 (f) is amended to read as follows:

“(f) A Commissioner shall receive no compensation for his services, but shall be entitled to payment of official travel costs and re-imbusement of expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the discharge of his duties and functions. Commissioners may be paid a reasonable per diem not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for attendance at official meetings of the Commission.”

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

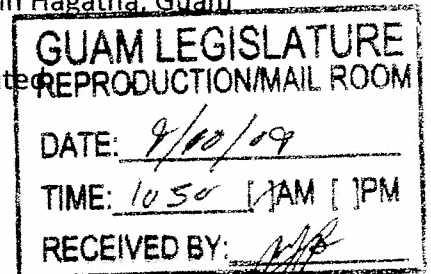

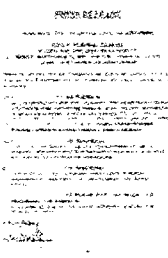

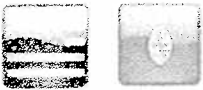

**AN ACT TO AMEND 12 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED
CHAPTER 5 §5103 (f) RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION FOR
COMMISSIONERS OF THE GUAM HOUSING AND URBAN
RENEWAL AUTHORITY**

BE IT ENACTED BY PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*

Finds that since its creation, the appointed commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority do not receive stipend for their attendance at office commission meetings. Other similar autonomous agencies within the government of Guam govern by a Board or Commission are authorized by law to compensate their members to receive a minimal stipend. *I Liheslatura* further finds, that Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority officials have conveyed that federal funding are available for the compensation of GHURA commissioners. Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to extend equity to commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal and authorizing compensation for commissioners similar to their counterparts in other autonomous

agencies.

Section 2. 12 GCA Chapter 5 §5103 (f) is amended to read as follows:

“(f) A Commissioner shall receive no compensation for his services, but shall be entitled to payment of official travel costs and re-imbusement of expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the discharge of his duties and functions. Commissioners may be paid a reasonable per diem not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for attendance at official meetings of the Commission.”

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
