

**AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 30-216, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING ADDITIONAL TIME TO UTILIZE FUNDS FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF SCHOOL BUSES AND PUBLIC SAFETY VEHICLES AND THE REALLOCATION OF SURPLUS FUNDS TO FUND PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE ON SCHOOL BUSES**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that it is  
3 critical to support the efforts of the Department of Public Works (DPW), Guam Fire  
4 Department (GFD) and Guam Police Department (GPD) in repairing vehicles utilized to  
5 provide bussing, public safety and emergency services. Although the respective  
6 organizations have achieved significant progress, the procurement of tools and vehicle  
7 parts within the prescribed April 13, 2011 deadline is not possible due to extenuating  
8 circumstances beyond the control of the implementing organizations. *I Liheslaturan*  
9 *Guåhan* finds it necessary to provide an extension to the prescribed deadline to complete  
10 the balance of efforts needed to accomplish the objectives of P.L. 30-216.

11 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that additional funding is required to perform  
12 quarterly preventative maintenance services on school buses to provide reliable and safe  
13 school bus services.

14 **Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law 30-216 is hereby amended to read:**

16 **“Section 3. Timely Completion of Maintenance Services.**

17 (a) The DPW Director shall exercise best management practices to ensure that  
18 ~~Subsections (1), (2) and (6) of Section 2 (a) of this Act can be completed by August 15,~~

1 ~~2011~~ within ninety (90) days, but not later than one hundred twenty (120) days.

2 (b) The Department of Public Works, Guam Fire Department and Guam Police  
3 Department are hereby authorized, through the applicable procurement rules and  
4 regulations of the General Services Agency, to augment maintenance service capacity by  
5 procuring the services of private sector maintenance businesses capable of completing the  
6 purposes referenced in Section 2 of this Act.

7 (c) All amounts appropriated by this Act which are not encumbered ~~or expended~~  
8 ~~within one hundred twenty (120) days of the effective date of this Act by August 15,~~  
9 2011 shall revert to the original sources the Department of Public Works Transportation-  
10 Maintenance Division for preventative maintenance further specified in subsection (a)(2)  
11 of Section 2, Public Law 30-216.

12 (d) The Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to maximize the  
13 funding for and the construction of wooden bus shelters as authorized by this Act by  
14 partnering with the Guam Trades Academy.”

15 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this law or its application to any person or  
16 circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect  
17 other provisions or applications of this law which can be given effect without the invalid  
18 provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this law are severable.
