



COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education and Public Libraries convened a public hearing on June 23, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 213-31 (COR) "An act to repeal § 6108 of Chapter 6, Article 1 of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to sick persons," sponsored by Senator Aline A. Yamashita.

Notices were disseminated via fax and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on June 15, 2011 (5-Day Notice), and again on June 20, 2011 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. convened the public hearing to order at 2:00 p.m. and announced the agenda of the public hearing. Bill No. 213-31 (COR) was announced as one of the items on the agenda to be heard by the Committee.

- **Senator Yamashita, Ph.D.** stated Bill No. 213 is really about updating statutes. She stated this section refers to people with mental or physical disability as sick people. She stated in the past it may have been appropriate, however certainly today with ADA, I.D.E.A and 504 it's no longer appropriate. She stated that Public Law 27-17 addresses all of special education processes and this simply is an act to repeal a certain part of our statute whose time has come to retire.

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** called for Mr. Sanchez who signed up to testify, however he was not present when the bill was heard.

There being no further questions or comments, Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. concluded the hearing for Bill No. 213-31 (COR).




