

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF PUBLIC LAW 30-216, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING ADDITIONAL TIME TO UTILIZE FUNDS FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF SCHOOL BUSES AND PUBLIC SAFETY VEHICLES, AND THE REALLOCATION OF SURPLUS FUNDS TO FUND PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE ON SCHOOL BUSES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that it is critical to support the efforts of the Department of Public Works (DPW),
- 4 the Guam Fire Department (GFD) and the Guam Police Department (GPD) in

- 1 repairing vehicles utilized to provide bussing, public safety and emergency
- 2 services. Although the respective organizations have achieved significant
- 3 progress, the procurement of tools and vehicle parts within the prescribed April 13,
- 4 2011 deadline is *not* possible due to extenuating circumstances beyond the control
- 5 of the implementing organizations. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds it necessary to
- 6 provide an extension to the prescribed deadline to complete the balance of efforts
- 7 needed to accomplish the objectives of P.L. 30-216.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that additional funding is required to perform quarterly preventative maintenance services on school buses to provide

reliable and safe school bus services.

**Section 2.** Section 3 of Public Law 30-216 is hereby *amended* to read:

### "Section 3. Timely Completion of Maintenance Services.

- (a) The Directors of the DPW, GFD and GPD *shall* exercise best management practices to ensure that procurement documents pertinent to Section 2 (a) of this Act are completed and transmitted to the General Services Agency (GSA) by July 15, 2011.
- (b) The Department of Public Works, the Guam Fire Department and Guam Police Department are hereby authorized, through the applicable procurement rules and regulations of the General Services Agency, to augment maintenance service capacity by procuring the services of private sector maintenance businesses capable of completing the purposes referenced in Section 2 of this Act.
- (c) All amounts appropriated by this Act which are *not* encumbered by August 15, 2011 *shall* transfer to the Department of Public Works Transportation Maintenance Division for preventative maintenance services specified in Section 2 (a)(2) of this Act.
  - (d) The Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to

maximize the funding for and the construction of wooden bus shelters as 1 authorized by this Act by partnering with the Guam Trades Academy and 2 3 the Guam Community College." **Section 3.** Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to 4 5 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be 6 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the 7 8 provisions of this Law are severable..
