Dear Madame Speaker:

Attached is Bill No. 385-31 (COR), entitled, "**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 89.15 TO CHAPTER 89 OF TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EMPLOYMENT LIMITATIONS ON CONVICTED SEX OFFENDERS,**" which I have signed into law on December 10, 2012, as **Public Law 31-248.**

Public Law 31-248 prohibits the employment of convicted sex offenders in certain occupations, including medical, dental, and educational facilities where patients or children are present. These types of facilities and occupations are licensed and properly the subject of government regulation, and the protections afforded by new Title 9, G.C.A. Section 89.15 are consistent with the need to protect the public and ensure the delivery of quality services.

I wish to express concern, however, over the fact that the bill makes no distinction between the various degrees of criminal sexual conduct or the foreseeable risk of harm. By prohibiting a private employer engaged in the identified occupations from hiring an employee convicted of a sex offense, new Section 89.15 may be interpreted as being over regulatory and possibly violative of due process.

I applaud *i Liheslatura's* efforts to create a safer environment for the people, and especially for our children. I remain committed to furthering the protection of all citizens from those who would intentionally do them harm.





COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

Bill No. 385-31 (COR) — “An act to add a new §89.15 to Chapter 89 of 9GCA relative to employment limitations on convicted sex offenders.” — Senator V. Anthony Ada

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement & Judiciary convened the public hearing on December 13, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 385-31 (COR) - “An act to add a new §89.15 to Chapter 89 of 9GCA relative to employment limitations on convicted sex offenders” sponsored by Senator V. Anthony Ada.

Public Hearing Requirements:

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on December 5, 2011 (5-day Notice) and on December 7 and 9, 2011 (48-Hour notice), pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

Phillip Tydingco, Chief Deputy Attorney General, Office of the Attorney General, provided oral testimony on the Bill.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr., convened the public hearing at 9:00 a.m., read the agenda, recognized the Senators in attendance, explained the procedures of the public hearing, and deferred to its primary sponsor, Senator V. Anthony Ada, to provide an overview of the Bill.

Senator V. Anthony Ada stated that sex offenders sometimes use deceit in their offenses. He cited the high rate of recidivism for sex offenders. He said that sex offenders are restricted in their employment and that this Bill would further restrict employment in businesses where sex offenders would be exposed to potentially vulnerable groups.

Mr. Phil Tydingco said that the Office of the Attorney General supports the intent of the bill, to restrict employment where the most vulnerable groups may come into contact with sex offenders. He discussed the potential exposure of pedophiles to young children and other opportunities to reoffend that may arise due to employment.

Chairman Palacios expressed his support for the intent of the Bill, but suggested that amendment might be needed. He said that it might allow hiring in a more restricted form. He suggested that perhaps a sex offender could be hired as a night janitor, for example, at the facilities mentioned in the bill. Mr. Tydingco said that he does not know what law the Bill is modeled after. He stated that the bill has some qualifications that restrict cases where persons could be employed. Chairman Palacios suggested that there could be amendment to the bill. Mr. Tydingco said that perhaps there should be an inclusion of residential treatment programs for vulnerable groups like the elderly or disabled.

Senator Ada thanked the Chief Deputy Attorney General for his input.

Chairman Palacios declared that Bill No. 385-31 (COR) has been duly heard. The Chairman concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted. He adjourned the hearing at 10:10 a.m.

III. WRITTEN TESTIMONIES

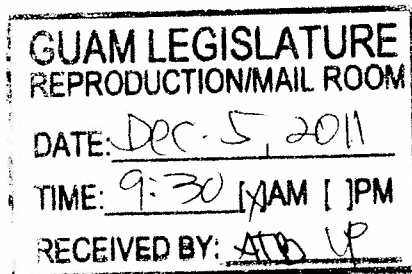





5 **§89.15. Limitations on Employment of Convicted Sex Offenders.** Any person

7 to register as a Sex Offender pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter, may not be
8 employed, directly or through an independent contractor, in any of the following:

12 (b) A child care facility while children are present,

13 (c) A school or learning institution while children are present,

14 (d) A medical or disabled person transport service while patients are present,

15 (e) A Nursing home or hospice facility, and

16 (f) Installers/deliverers of services or goods where the employee may be required
17 to enter a private residence.
