



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §1105 OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE 9,
GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, RELATIVE TO
THE IMPORTATION OF CATTLE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §1105 of Chapter 1, Title 9, Guam Administrative Rules, is
3 hereby *amended* to read as follows:

4 “§1105. **Importation of Cattle.**

5 (a) Requirements Governing Entry. No cattle shall be
6 permitted entry into Guam *unless* the same have complied with
7 requirements generally applicable to the introduction of all classes,

1 types or species of animals into Guam and with each of the following
2 additional requirements:

3 (1) They *shall* have been tested by a qualified
4 veterinarian and found to be free from tuberculosis within thirty
5 (30) days prior to shipment; provided, however, dairy cattle
6 *shall* additionally originate in a herd or herds, that are *not* under
7 quarantine for tuberculosis;

8 (2) (A) They *shall* have been tested by a qualified
9 veterinarian and found to be free of brucellosis by a serum
10 agglutination test performed in an official laboratory within
11 thirty (30) days prior to shipment; provided, however, that
12 heifers and bulls under thirty (30) months of age that have been
13 vaccinated by a qualified veterinarian with a standard dose of
14 United States Department of Agriculture approved Brucella
15 Vaccine under an official state or federal plan that provides for
16 official identification of the animal and the recording of the
17 vaccination at the time of vaccination may be admitted into
18 Guam without the agglutination test requirement; or

19 (B) The brucellosis card test, on a negative test result,
20 will also be acceptable as an official screening test for bovine
21 brucellosis for entry into Guam. The test *shall* be conducted by
22 a Category II accredited veterinarian or a veterinarian
23 authorized by the USDA-APHIS Veterinary Services Area
24 Veterinarian in Charge for the Pacific U.S. Territories and
25 Commonwealth, and could be performed in the field and *not*
26 necessarily in a federally-approved diagnostic laboratory.

1 (3) They *shall* be accompanied by a certificate or certificates
2 issued or approved by a veterinary officer of the United States
3 Department of Agriculture Animal Health Division, or by the State
4 Veterinarian for the state of origin, attesting that the above
5 requirements have been fulfilled. Said certificate *shall* give a
6 description of each animal (ear tag numbers or other marks of
7 identification), and *shall* certify that the animals described therein are
8 free from contagious and communicable diseases;

9 (4) They *shall* be entered through the Commercial Port of
10 Guam or any other Guam Port, where adequate animal quarantine
11 station facilities, including the owner's or importer's cattle facilities,
12 are established and approved by the Department, and quarantined in
13 such quarantine stations *not to exceed* thirty (30) days to be tested for
14 tuberculosis and such other communicable diseases as the Territorial
15 Veterinarian may deem necessary. Anaplasmosis testing *shall* be
16 exempted. While in quarantine they *shall* be sprayed or dipped with
17 an approved insecticide. Such animals *shall not* be released from
18 quarantine until the Territorial Veterinarian is satisfied that the same
19 are free from tuberculosis or any other communicable disease or
20 parasite. All expenses in connection with the examination, testing,
21 treating or destruction and disposal of cattle while in quarantine *shall*
22 be borne by the owner, importer or consignee."


