



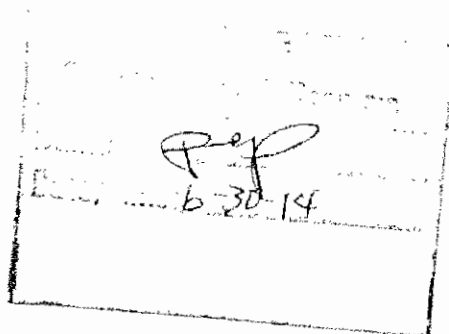

Dear Speaker Won Pat:

Recently, the Guam Memorial Hospital Administrator Joseph Verga stated that the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) has not received the estimated funds in the GMHA Health Care Trust and Development Fund as promised with the passage of Public Law 32-060. Furthermore, Verga stated that the Legislature has not appropriated the remaining 40 percent in the fund to the hospital to subsidize the delivery of healthcare services.

Given the fiscal struggles of GMHA and an impending funding shortfall with the Medicaid Program, Bill No. 312-32(LS), introduced on April 09, 2014, provides the annual allocation and appropriation funding authority from GMHA Healthcare Trust Fund to the GMHA for the sole purposes of: (1) local matching funds for the Medicaid program, specifically for patients seen and treated at the GMHA; (2) used as additional debt service payments for any existing borrowing by the Authority; and (3) funding for medication, supplies, and medical equipment.

Nevertheless, Bill No. 312-32(LS) is less than a true fix to GMHA's chronic budgetary problems. However, with the support of Senator Dennis Rodriguez, Chairman of Health and Human Services, Senator Ben Pangelinan, Chairman of Appropriations, and all of my colleagues; the continuous appropriation of this bill will allow the funds to be used for its intended purposes.

I am kindly requesting the public hearing requirement to be waived for Bill No. 312-32 (LS) - an Act relative to appropriating the funds in the in the GMHA Healthcare Trust and Development fund to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority pursuant to Public Law 32-060; by amending subsection "(B)" of §97103, Chapter 97, Article 1, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated. Your consideration and approval of my request to waive the public hearing requirement would be greatly appreciated.
