

**AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTIONS (b) AND (c) OF §
85103 OF CHAPTER 85, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM COUNCIL
ON THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Subsection (b) of § 85103 of Chapter 85, Title 5, Guam Code
3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

4 “(b) Composition. The governing board *shall* consist of thirteen
5 (13) members, twelve (12) of whom *shall* be appointed by *I Maga’lahi* (the
6 Governor) with the advice and consent of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature).
7 The thirteenth (13th) member *shall* be appointed by *I Maga’lahi* from among

1 the members of the Mayors Council of Guam, and *shall not* be subject to the
2 advice and consent of *I Liheslatura*. *I Maga'lahi*, when making initial
3 appointments, *shall* designate six (6) members to serve for two (2) year
4 terms, and six (6) members to serve for four (4) year terms. Subsequent
5 appointments *shall* be for terms of four (4) years, except that when a
6 vacancy occurs, it *shall* be filled by appointment of *I Maga'lahi* with the
7 advice and consent of *I Liheslatura* for the remainder of the vacating
8 member's term."

9 **Section 2.** Subsection (c) of § 85103 of Chapter 85, Title 5, Guam Code
10 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

11 "(c) Qualifications. With the exception of the one (1) member who
12 *shall* be appointed from among the members of the Mayors Council of
13 Guam, members of the governing board *shall* be appointed from among
14 male and female residents of Guam, selected at-large, who have recognized
15 the professional interest and experience in or who are widely known for their
16 interest in the arts and humanities. The governing board *shall* have at least
17 two (2) members to represent the following areas: performing arts, visual
18 arts, literature and folk arts."
