



**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL
YEAR 2014 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX (HOT) SURPLUS
FUND TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU FOR A
PILOT PROGRAM TO SUPPORT THE NEEDS OF THE
GROWING KOREAN VISITOR MARKET.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Korean visitor market is proving to be an important market due to an increase
4 in arrivals. Efforts are needed to sustain the growing number of first-time Korean
5 visitors to the island and maintain growth in visitor arrivals through the creation of
6 a pilot program for support services.

1 **Section 2. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any provision of law, the sum
2 of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (**\$250,000**) is hereby appropriated from the
3 Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Guam Visitors Bureau
4 for the purpose of establishing a pilot program to provide concierge, emergency
5 hotline, translation, language-friendly hospital/clinic referrals, transportation
6 assistance, and any other support services that can enhance the visitor experience for
7 our growing Korean visitor market. Notwithstanding the general provisions of §
8 30107.1 of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA, this appropriation *shall* continue to be
9 available until expended and is *not* subject to transfer or use for any other purpose.
