





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) FROM THE UNRESERVED FUND BALANCE OF THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2015 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES TO PAY THE PREMIUMS FOR FOSTER CHILDREN HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that Public Law 32-189 provides that foster children are included in the Government
- 4 of Guam Group Health Insurance Plan, with the full cost of health insurance

- 1 provided by the government of Guam. *I Liheslatura* remains committed to providing
- 2 quality health insurance to foster children, who are wards of the State.
- 3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the General Fund appropriation of
- 4 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) for Fiscal Year 2016 was based
- 5 on the historical average of ninety (90) foster children.
- 6 I Liheslatura finds that the foster children population is over two hundred
- 7 (200), so additional funds are needed to provide health insurance to the foster
- 8 children as required under Public Law 32-189.
- 9 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate Four
- Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) from the unreserved fund balance of the
- Healthy Futures Fund as of September 30, 2015, to provide health insurance to foster
- 12 children.
- 13 Section 2. Appropriation for Foster Children Health Insurance
- 14 **Premiums.** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, Four Hundred Thousand
- Dollars (\$400,000) is hereby appropriated from the unreserved fund balance of the
- Healthy Futures Fund as of September 30, 2015 to the Department of Public Health
- and Social Services (DPHSS) for the purpose of paying the premiums for health
- insurance provided to foster children pursuant to Public Law 32-189. The DPHSS
- 19 Bureau of Social Services Administration shall be the subscriber for foster children
- 20 covered under Public Law 32-189, and shall remit payments to the Department of
- 21 Administration or to the insurance provider for the purpose of paying the premiums.
