AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$820,000) FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX UNRESERVED FUND BALANCE TO THE GUAM MUSEUM FUND FOR MUSEUM OPERATIONAL CASH FLOW.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that there exists approximately Two Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 4 (\$2,300,000) in the Fiscal Year 2015 Hotel Occupancy Tax Unreserved Fund
- 5 Balance available for appropriation. The sum of Eight Hundred Twenty Thousand

- 1 Dollars (\$820,000) is needed to carry out the operations of the Guam and Chamorro
- 2 Educational Facility (Guam Museum) for Fiscal Year 2016.
- 3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Guam Museum is a necessary
- 4 component of our tourism industry. It is an important resource that will tell the four
- 5 thousand (4,000) year old story of the island of Guam and her people. The Guam
- 6 Museum will place the Chamorro culture front and center as Guam's unique
- 7 competitive differentiator, and aid the Guam Visitors Bureau in fulfilling Objective
- 8 Five of its Tourism 2020 plan; and the Guam Museum will enhance the visitor
- 9 experience as a unique cultural destination.
- 10 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide the Guam
- 11 Museum with funding for Fiscal Year 2016.
- 12 **Section 2.** Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 13 sum of Eight Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$820,000) is appropriated from
- 14 the Fiscal Year 2015 Hotel Occupancy Tax Unreserved Fund Balance to the Guam
- 15 Museum Fund for the purpose of providing the Guam Museum with an operational
- cash flow to ensure the Guam Museum's operations to the end of Fiscal Year 2016.
- 17 This appropriation shall not lapse and shall remain available for the purpose
- 18 identified herein until fully expended.
- 19 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application
- 20 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 21 any other provision or application of this Act that can be given effect without the
- 22 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 23 severable.
