





- Section 1. A new § 19.80 is added to Chapter 19, Title 9, Guam Code

1	(a) A person is guilty of strangulation if he knowingly or					
2	intentionally, against the will of another, impedes the normal breathing of

8	Section 2. A new § 30.10 (a)(3) is added to Chapter 30, Title 9, Guam Code
