

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 1515(i) OF ARTICLE 5,
CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 1, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM AND
CHAMORRO EDUCATIONAL FACILITY.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
3 recognizes that various factors have resulted in the need to provide funding in
4 addition to the Twenty-Seven Million Dollars (\$27,000,000) appropriated under
5 Public Law 30-228 for the acquisition, construction and equipping of the Guam
6 and Chamorro Educational Facility (GCEF). It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan*
7 *Guåhan* to provide *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* with the authority to supplement funding

8 for the GCEF using available proceeds from the Series 2011A Hotel Occupancy
9 Tax Bond.

10 **Section 2.** § 1515(i) of Article 5, Chapter 1, Division 1, Title 5, Guam
11 Code Annotated, is *amended* to read as follows:

12 “(i) Infrastructure Improvement Projects. The proceeds of the new
13 money bonds issued under this Section are hereby appropriated in amounts
14 not to exceed the following amounts for the purposes of implementing the
15 following projects, in the following order of priority:

16 (1) Sixty-Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
17 (\$68,500,000) for the following projects:

18 (A) for the acquisition, construction, and equipping of an
19 educational facility that reflects a sense of Guam and the *Chamorro*
20 culture and will be the permanent home for the preservation and
21 continuance of the *Chamorro* people; provides for the display of
22 artifacts and historical documents; stimulates community
23 involvement; fosters research and conveys the results of research to
24 the public primarily through the medium of public exhibits,
25 demonstrations, lectures, public programs and publications using the
26 theme: *I Hinanao-ta*, the journey of the *Chamorro* people; provided,
27 however, that the location of such educational facility *shall* have been
28 approved by *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* prior to acquisition (if any) or
29 construction thereof;”

30 **Section 3.** Subsections A through W of § 1515(i) of Article 5, Chapter 1,
31 Division 1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, are renumbered to Subsections B
32 through X, accordingly, to reflect that the Guam and Chamorro Educational
33 Facility is the highest priority project.

34 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this act or its application to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act that can be given effect without the
37 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are
38 severable.
