



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX (HOT) SURPLUS FUND TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- that there exists Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) in the
- 4 Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund available for appropriation.
- 5 Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the
- 6 sum of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000) is hereby appropriated from
- 7 the Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Guam Visitors
- 8 Bureau for operational needs and for the costs associated with hosting the

- 1 upcoming Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) meeting. Notwithstanding the
- 2 general provisions of § 30107.1, of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA, this appropriation
- 3 shall continue to be available until expended and is not subject to transfer or use
- 4 for any other purpose.
