



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX (HOT) SURPLUS FUND TO THE *HAGÅTÑA* RESTORATION AND REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR OPERATIONAL NEEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that there exists Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) in the
- 4 Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund available for appropriation.
- 5 Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the
- 6 sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) is hereby appropriated from

- 1 the Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Hagåtña
- 2 Restoration and Redevelopment Authority (HRRA) for the Hagåtña River
- 3 Channeling & Watershed Hydrologic Feasibility study. Notwithstanding the
- 4 general provisions of § 30107.1 of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA, this appropriation
- 5 shall continue to be available until expended and is not subject to transfer or use
- 6 for any other purpose.
