An Act making appropriation for the operation of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are appropriated out of any General Fund Surplus in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, for the operation of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956:

Section 2. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed

twenty per cent (20%) of any appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item or items of the appropriation of Section 1, but no item of appropriation shall be increased more than twenty per centum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Whenever in order to promote efficiency and economy of operation of the executive branch of the Government, the Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for the administration of any function or program from one department to another department of the Government of Guam, he may also direct the transfer of funds allocated to such function or program, motwithstanding the amount so transferred is in excess of twenty per cent (20%) of the total amount appropriated for either such department. Section 3. This is an urgency measure and shall become effective upon approval by the Governor.
