

16 An Act to provide funds for continuing
17 construction of Guam Memorial Hospital;
18 to authorize and provide funds for the
19 conversion of the nursing school building
20 into a general hospital building;
21 to establish funds for student nurse
22 training.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF
24 GUAM:

25 Section 1. The continuation of construction of
26 Guam Memorial Hospital and the conversion of the nursing
27 school building to a general hospital building are hereby
28 authorized.

29 Section 2. There is appropriated from any General
30 Fund Surplus in the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated,
31 the sum of \$800,000.00 for the purpose authorized in
32 Section 1 of this Act, \$91,818.00 of this appropriation shall
be made available immediately, and the balance of this appropriation shall be made available July 1, 1955.

33 Section 3. There is hereby established within the
34 government of Guam a continuing special fund which is for the
35 purpose of providing necessary loans to students who are in
36 or are entering nurse's training and who are United States
37 citizens and residents of Guam. Such loans shall be made to
38 defray the costs of travel, tuition, board and room, and
39 similar educational expenses in connection with nurse's

1 training in the United States or its Territories.

2 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any
3 General Fund Surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise
4 appropriated, the sum of \$20,000 which shall be and become
5 a part of the Student Loan Fund created by Public Law 118,
6 Second Guam Legislature for the objectives and purposes
7 created by Section 3 hereof.

8 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any
9 General Fund Surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise
10 appropriated, the sum of \$66,500 for the following purposes:

- 11 (1) To provide additional quonsets for
12 school buildings, the sum of \$16,500.
- 13 (2) To complete the Government House, the
14 sum of \$20,000.
- 15 (3) To provide for the initial engineering and
16 design of the proposed new Administration
17 Building, the sum of \$7,000.
- 18 (4) To complete the remodeling and rehabilitation
19 of certain buildings of the Department of
20 Finance previously authorized and appropriated
21 for by Section 4, Public Law 1, Second Guam
22 Legislature, 1954 (Third) Special Session,
23 the sum of \$5,000.
- 24 (5) To provide for the electrical wiring and
25 completion of construction of the Inarajan
26 School, the sum of \$16,500.
- 27 (6) To provide a dispensary at Agana Heights,
28 the sum of \$1,500.00.

29 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any
30 General Fund Surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise
31 appropriated, the sum of \$95,000 for the following purposes:

- 32 (1) For the purchase of new school buses,

1 the sum of \$45,000.

2 (2) For the purchase of construction
3 equipment for the Department of Public
4 Works, the sum of \$50,000.

5 Section 7. Every appropriation made herein except
6 the appropriation made by Section 4, above, shall be available
7 for expenses incident to the project for which the appropri-
8 ation is made including expenses of administration, planning,
9 supervision and other similar expenses. Each appropriation
10 made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall
11 be available until expended for the purpose and project for
12 which the appropriation is made.

13 Section 8. This is an urgency measure and shall
14 become effective upon the approval by the Governor.
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
