The holidays of this 9 territory are: 10 (a) Every Sunday. 77 Christmas Day, December 25 12 (c) New Year's Day, January 1 13 14 (d) Washington's Birthday, February 22 (e) Memorial Day, May 30 15 (f) Independence Day, July 4 16 Liberation Day, July 21 17 (g) (h) Labor Day, first Monday in September 18 19 (i) Veterans Day, November 11 (j) Every day on which an election is held 20 throughout Guam 21 (k) Every day appointed by the President 22 of the United States or the Governor 23 24 of Guam for a public fast, Thanksgiving 25 day or holiday." Section 2. Sec. 220 of the Government Code of Guam 26 27 is hereby amended to read as follows: 28 "Sec. 220. Liberation Day. The 21st day of 29 July in each year shall be known as Liberation Day. 30 and is hereby made a legal public holiday in the 31 territory of Guam in commemoration of the anniversary

of the liberation of Guam from the enemy on July

July 21, 1944, and the inauguration of civil government of Guam on July 21, 1950." Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor.
