

Bill No. 11

Introduced by Committee on Housing and
Transportation, by request

An Act to provide for the construction,
rehabilitation, and furnishing of govern-
ment staff quarters for authorized personnel.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. It is the purpose of this act to enable the govern-
ment to continue to secure needed off-island personnel in accordance
with the provisions of the Organic Act and Section 4110, Chapter 2,
Title 5, of the Government Code by providing suitable living quarters
for the use of authorized personnel.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any General Fund
Surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, the sum
of \$83,000 for the construction and furnishing of eight staff houses.
This appropriation is in addition to the appropriations previously
made by Section 5 and Section 6 of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legisla-
ture, 1954 (Third) Special Session.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any General Fund
Surplus of the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, the sum
of \$165,000 for the construction of an apartment building for the
housing of authorized personnel.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any General Fund
Surplus of the Treasury of Guam, the sum of \$40,000 for the purpose of
replacing or rehabilitating furnishings and rehabilitating buildings
of existing housing quarters.

Section 5. Every appropriation made herein shall be available
for expenses incident to the project for which the appropriation is
made including the expenses of administration, planning, supervision,
and other similar expenses. Each appropriation made herein shall
continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended

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for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed.

Section 6. All of the construction and rehabilitation projects herein authorized shall be constructed by employees of the government of Guam and shall not be laid out on bid or other contract.

Section 7. This is an urgency measure and shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor.
