



11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY  
12 OF GUAM:

13 Section 1. Section 9318 of the Government Code  
14 of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 "Section 9318. Certified copies: Fees.  
16 Upon request of any person, a certified copy  
17 of the records of a birth, death, or marriages,  
18 under the control of the office shall be issued  
19 upon payment of a fee of fifty cents (\$0.50)  
20 for each copy so issued."

21 Section 2. Section 9002 is hereby added to the  
22 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

23 "Section 9002. The Director of Medical  
24 Services may furnish a copy of any record,  
25 upon request, for a fee of fifty cents (\$0.50)  
26 per page and an added fee of fifty cents  
27 (\$0.50) for each certification requested  
28 except as provided in Section 9318."

29 Section 3. Section 9003 is hereby added to the  
30 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

31 "Section 9003. Notwithstanding any  
32 other provisions of this section, the United  
States Government and the government of Guam,  
their instrumentalities and agencies, shall  
not be charged a fee for the furnishing of

any certificate, record, copies or  
certified copies thereof under this  
title."

Section 4. This Act is an uregency measure and  
shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor.
