8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY
9	OF GUAM:
10	Section 1. Section 9318 of the Government Code
11	of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:
12	"Section 9318. Certified copies: Fees.
13	Upon request of any person, a certified copy
14	of the records of a birth, death, or marriages,
15	under the control of the office shall be issued
16	upon payment of a fee of fifty cents (\$0.50)
17	for each copy so issued."
18	Section 2. Section 9002 is hereby added to the
19	Government Code of Guam to read as follows:
20	"Section 9002. The Director of Medical
21	Services may furnish a copy of any record,
22	upon request, for a fee of fifty cents (\$0.50)
23	per page and an added fee of fifty cents
24	(\$0.50) for each certification requested
25	except as provided in Section 9318."
26	Section 3. Section 9003 is hereby added to the
27	Government Code of Guam to read as follows:
28	"Section 9003. Notwithstanding any
29	other provisions of this section, the United
30	States Government and the government of Guam,
31	their instrumentalities and agencies, shall
32	not be charged a fee for the furnishing of

ı	any certificate, record, copies or
2	certified copies thereof under this
3	title."
4	Section 4. This Act is an uregency measure and
5	shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor.
