






8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY  
9 OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. Section 6401 of the Government Code  
11 of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 6401. Same: renewal. Patents,  
13 copyrights or trade-marks renewed in the United  
14 States Patent Office must likewise be renewed  
15 with the government of Guam, if protection is to  
16 be extended by the government, and the procedure  
17 as set forth in Section 6400 of this chapter  
18 is required for such renewal, with the addition  
19 that a certified copy of the renewal granted by  
20 the United States must be furnished; provided,  
21 that if a certified copy of the original regis-  
22 tration has been filed in Guam, then another copy  
23 need not be furnished with the notice of renewal."
