An Act to amend Section 6401 of the Government Code of Guam, relating to the renewal of patents, copyrights and trade-marks.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6401 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6401. Same: renewal. Patents, copyrights or trade-marks renewed in the United States Patent Office must likewise be renewed with the government of Guam, if protection is to be extended by the government, and the procedure as set forth in Section 6400 of this chapter is required for such renewal, with the addition that a certified copy of the renewal granted by the United States must be furnished; provided, that if a certified copy of the original registration has been filed in Guam, then another copy need not be furnished with the notice of renewal."
