

An Act to add Section 11005 to the Govern-  
ment Code to name the grammar school in  
the Municipality of Umatac the Francisco  
Q. Sanchez School.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11005 is hereby added to the Government  
Code to read as follows:

"Section 11005. The existing grammar school  
located in the Municipality of Umatac is hereby named  
and designated the 'Francisco Q. Sanchez School' and  
the Department of Education shall, at such ceremony  
as the Director deems appropriate, officially so  
designate said school, and provide also such lettering  
or signs upon the entrance thereof indicating the name  
of said school as may be consistent with similar iden-  
tification of other schools within the territory."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take  
effect upon its approval by the Governor.
