






13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF
14 GUAM:

15 Section 1. Section 4117 of the Government Code of
16 Guam is hereby amended to read:

17 "Section 4117. Reassignment of classes.

18 The Governor may, upon the recommendation of the
19 Personnel Board when he finds the economic conditions
20 warrant the necessity therefor, reassign classes of
21 positions to higher or lower pay ranges within the
22 pay range schedule than those to which they are
23 assigned in Section 4103 of this Compensation
24 Law; provided, however, that all classes of
25 positions in the classified service are reassigned
26 at one and the same time and in the same manner
27 and to the same extent. The provisions of this
28 section are not intended to nor shall they in any
29 way limit the authority conferred upon the Governor
30 by Section 4108 of this Compensation Law."

31 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure and shall
32 take effect upon its approval by the Governor.
