



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





5 An Act to add new sections to Chapter
6 2, Title XXXV of the Government Code
7 of Guam relating to good time allow-
8 ances for prisoners.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF
10 GUAM:

11 Section 1. Section 39100.1 is hereby added to Chapter
12 2, Title XXXV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

13 "Section 39100.1. Eligibility for Parole.

14 Any person confined in the Guam Penitentiary,
15 except persons under sentence of death or treason,
16 shall be eligible for parole after he has served the
17 minimum period of time of his sentence as prescribed
18 by Section 39100 and as such minimum period of time
19 is reduced by allowance of time for good conduct as
20 hereinafter provided by this chapter."

21 Section 2. Section 39115 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
22 Title XXXV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

23 "Section 39115. Good time allowance. Every
24 person confined in the Guam Penitentiary on any
25 judgment of conviction, except persons under
26 sentence of death or treason, shall be entitled
27 to a deduction from the term of his sentence
28 beginning with the day on which the sentence
29 commences to run, to be credited as earned and
30 computed monthly, provided that he observes all
31 the rules of the institution and has not been
32 punished, as follows:

(a) Five days for each month, if the
sentence is not less than six months and not

1 more than one year.

2 (b) Six days for each month, if the
3 sentence is more than one year and less than
4 three years.

5 (c) Seven days for each month, if the
6 sentence is not less than three years and less
7 than five years.

8 (d) Eight days for each month, if the
9 sentence is not less than five years and less
10 than ten years.

11 (e) Ten days for each month, if the
12 sentence is ten years or more.

13 When two or more consecutive sentences are to
14 be served, the aggregate of the several sentences
15 shall be the basis upon which the deduction shall
16 be computed."

17 Section 3. Section 39116 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
18 Title XXXV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

19 "Section 39116. Release. A prisoner shall
20 be released at the expiration of his term of
21 sentence less the time deducted for good conduct.
22 A certificate of such deduction shall be entered
23 on the commitment order by the Director of Public
24 Safety of Guam."

25 Section 4. Section 39117 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
26 Title XXXV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

27 "Section 39117. Same: Parolee. A prisoner
28 having served the term or terms for which he shall
29 have been sentenced after the 21st day of July,
30 1950, less good time deductions, shall upon release
31 be treated as if released on parole, and shall be
32 subject to all provisions of law relating to the

1 parole until the expiration of the maximum
2 term or terms for which he was sentenced."

3 Section 5. Section 39118 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
4 Title XXXV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

5 "Section 39118. Forfeiture of Good Time
6 Allowance. If during the term of imprisonment
7 a prisoner commits any offense or violates the
8 rules of the Guam Penitentiary, all or any part
9 of his earned good time may be forfeited in the
10 discretion of the Director of Public Safety."

11 Section 6. Section 39119 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
12 Title XXXV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

13 "Section 39119. Restoration of forfeited
14 time. The Director of Public Safety may restore
15 any forfeited or lost good time or such portion
16 thereof as he deems proper under the circumstances."

17 Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure and shall
18 take effect immediately upon its approval by the Governor.

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
