


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. Section 24112 of the Government Code of Guam
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 24112. Service: means. The accusation and
13 all accompanying papers may be sent to respondent by any
14 means selected by the agency. But unless the respondent
15 has been served personally or by registered mail or by
16 leaving a copy of the accusation and accompanying papers
17 at his usual place of residence, or at his place of
18 business, with some person of suitable age and discretion
19 residing or working therein, or he shall have filed a
20 notice of defense or otherwise appeared, the agency
21 shall not make an order affecting adversely any rights
22 of the respondent. Service may be proved in the manner
23 authorized in civil actions. Service by registered mail
24 shall be effective if a statute or agency regulation
25 requires respondent to file his address with the agency
26 and to notify the agency of any change, and if a
27 registered letter containing the accusation and accompanying
28 papers is mailed, addressed to respondent at the latest
29 address on file with the agency. Service shall be made
30 by any officer or employee of the agency or may be made
31 by any person age 18 or over who has been authorized by
32 the agency."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take
effect upon its approval by the Governor.
