8	Section 1. Section 499a of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby	
9	amended to read as follows:	
10	"Section 499a. Stealing electricity, tampering with	
11	electric or water meters, misdemeanor. Every person who	
12	shall willfully, and knowingly with intent to injure or	
13	defraud, make or cause to be made any connection in any	
14	manner whatsoever with any electric wire or electric	
15	appliance of any character whatsoever operated by the	110
16	government or by any person, persons, or corporation	
17	authorized to generate, transmit, and sell electric	
18	current, or who shall so willfully and knowingly with	
19	intent to injure or defraud, use or cause to be used any	
20	such connection in such manner as to supply any electric	
21	current for heat or light or power to any electric lamp,	
22	or apparatus or device, by or at which electric current	
23	for heat or light or power is consumed or otherwise used	
24	or wasted, without passing through a meter for the measuring	No.
25	and registering of the quantity passing through such electric	
26	wire or apparatus, or who shall knowingly injure, alter, or	
27	procure to be injured or altered any electric or water	
28	meter or obstruct its working, or procure the same to	
29	be tampered with or injured, or use or cause to be used	
30	any electric or water meter or appliance so tampered with	1
31	or injured, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and	
32	shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$50 or by	

1	imprisonment not to exceed 3 months."
2	Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take
3	effect upon its approval by the Governor.
