Bubstitute Bill by Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources.

An Act to repeal Section 20001 of the Government Code, to enact a new Section 20001 thereof and to amend Section 20004 of the Government Code to change the composition of the Guam Finance Agency and to require that 40% of the Guarantee Fund be reserved and made available for agricultural purposes.

BE IT EMACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Section 20001 of the Government Sode of Guan is hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Section 20001 of the Government Code of Guan is hereby enacted to read:

"Sec. 20001. SAME: COMPOSITION AND EMPLOYERS. All the functions, powers and responsibilities of the Finance Agency shall be exercised by and under the direction of a five member Board of Administration (hereinafter sometimes called the 'Board') to be composed of five persons appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature for terms of four years each. Provided, however, that of the members first appointed three shall be appointed for terms of two years each. The Board may appoint an administrator and such other officers or employees me it deems necessary and may require any one or more of them to give bond in such amounts as it may prescribe. All persons employed by the Board shall, unless otherwise by law expressly provided, be employed, paid and shall held their offices or positions pursuent to the provisions

of law applicable to other officers and employees of the government of Guam; and their remuneration and wage scale shall be established in accordance with the provisions of law applicable to other emplayees of the government of Guess. The Office of the Attorney General shall not as legal counsel to the Board but no person within said office may become a member of said Board. Section 3. Section 20004 of Title XXI of the Govern-

ment Gode of Guam is hereby amended to read as fellows:

*Sec. 20004. DIRECT LOAMS. To further assist the development and advancement of agricultural, industrial, commercial, construction, housing and related pursuits in Guam, the Finance Agency may make direct loans to borrowers in those cases where adequate financing is not available on reasonable terms from a Lending Agency, even with a guarantee from the Guarantee Fund, for a project approved by the Board. Such loans may be made from, but only from, the Finance Agency Guarantee Fund and upon such terms and conditions and under such rules and regulations as the Board may prescribe; provided, however, that not less than forty per cent (40%) of the Guarantee Fund shall be reserved and made available for agricultural loans."
