An Act to make an appropriation for the contingent expenses of the Juvenile Court, Judicial Branch, government of Guam, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$17,130.00) is appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, for the contingent expenses of the Juvenile Court for juvenile care for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
