


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. The sum of Seventeen Thousand One Hundred
11 Thirty Dollars (\$17,130.00) is appropriated out of any moneys in
12 the Treasury of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, for the contingent
13 expenses of the Juvenile Court for juvenile care for the fiscal year
14 ending June 30, 1957.

15 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
