An Act to prohibit jay walking.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPIE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN: Section 1. Section 23127.6 of the Government Code is hereby amended to read:

> "Sec. 23127.6. Jay Walking. It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to cross any read at any point between adjacent intersections that are controlled by any traffic somerol signal device or police officer except in an officially designated crosswalk."
