



Introduced by A. L. Cristobal

An Act to prohibit jay walking.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 23127.6 of the Government Code is hereby amended to read:

"Sec. 23127.6. Jay Walking. It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to cross any road at any point between adjacent intersections that are controlled by any traffic control signal device or police officer except in an officially designated crosswalk."
