An Act to smend Public Law 5, First Regular Session, Third Gusm Legislature, relative to giving power and authority to the Chief Judge, Island Court of Gusm in the reallocation of funds within the Judicial Branch, government of Gusm.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Public Law 5, Pirst Regular Session, Third Guam Legislature, is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 2, to read as follows:

> "Section 2. The Chief Judge, Island Court of Guam is hereby authorized and empowered to reallocate the sum of \$1,000.00, or as much thereof as may be necessary, from the item 'Mitnesses fees' to the item 'Other Contractual Services', to cover necessary expenses in the partitioning of a room for the Police Court Judge's Chamber."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
