1956 (SECOND) Regular Session

Bill No. 164

Introduced by Committee on Housing and Transportation, by request.

An Act to amend Section 23301 of Title XIV, Chapter 3, of the Government Code of Guam to eliminate the requirement for the registration and licensing of bicycles under the Vehicle Code.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 23301 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 23301. Same. Subject to the exemptions stated in this title, registration of the following vehicles is required when driven or moved upon a highway: any motor vehicle, trailer, semi-trailer, pole or pipe dolly, and any dolly used to support part of the weight of a semi-trailer."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
